Aims of the Programmes

1 OBTAIN RECOGNIZED QUALIFICATIONS

Non-Chinese speakers in Hong Kong will obtain qualifications recognized by the government and different sectors and increase their employability by enhancing their basic capability in listening and speaking in Cantonese, as well as reading and writing in Chinese.

2 USE SPOKEN (CANTONESE) & WRITTEN CHINESE CONFIDENTLY

Non-Chinese speaking minority residents will use spoken (Cantonese) and written Chinese confidently in daily life and at work and be able to develop to become fluent speakers in Cantonese, or to learn written Chinese and become fluent in reading and writing Chinese in the future.

3 BE ABLE to HELP CHILDREN LEARN at SCHOOL

Parents of NCS students will understand the difficulties of their children in learning Chinese in mainstream schools so that they can encourage and provide appropriate assistance for their children learning at school.

4 ENGAGE with NATIVE CANTONESE SPEAKERS

Students will practice with volunteers whose mother tongue is Cantonese bi-weekly.

Entry Requirements

Applicants should be non-Chinese speaking Hong Kong residents aged 15 or above, with no or very limited ability in speaking Cantonese (for Listening & Speaking programme) / reading Chinese (for Literacy & Reading programme), and are currently not studying any full-time programme.

Programme Intended Learning Outcomes

2 Use simple Cantonese to communicate with others in daily life;

3 Use simple Cantonese grammar and vocabulary for work in different industries;

4 Conduct short conversations and reports on familiar topics in Cantonese.

Award

On successful completion of the programme with 75% attendance and graded D or above, students will be awarded within HKU system through HKU SPACE a Foundation Certificate in Vocational Chinese Language for NCS School Leavers (Listening and Speaking). (Pegged at QF Level 1)

1. Written Test – 1 hour (50%)
2. Speaking Test – 2 minutes (50%)
