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Guidance notes for completing the Professional Doctorate in Education (EdD) application form.

Your application for the EdD requires:

- 1. Completion of a HKUSPACE /UoP Application Form
 - a. Completion of a personal statement on rationale for undertaking a professional doctorate
 - Submission of Research Idea

 (a and b) can be completed in the application form or submitted as separate documents.
- 2. Up To Date CV
- 3. Submission of the certified true copies of your qualifications certificates & transcripts
- 4. Completion of the HKUSPACE Cambridge Linguaskills General English test to standard 176 or above, or equivalent as per UoP admissions requirements*
- 5. Submission of an example of your written work. This can be a piece of work from your Master's degree(Level 7) academic qualification (written in English, with no less than 2,000 words). The work presented should be solely authored by yourself. Please discuss with Dr Amos Yung, the EdD programme leader at HKU SPACE, for alternatives if not available.
- 6. 2 x References preferable one academic and one professional from a current/past employer. Where an academic reference is not possible, please discuss with Dr Amos Yung.

Acceptance onto the EdD is subject to an Interview by the UoP Programme Director and another senior member of the academic team.

Guidance on completing the Research Idea.

Please provide a proposed title for your Research Idea.

Your Research Idea should be approximately 1,000 words.

The first two years of the EdD will provide you with the frameworks and tools for your final proposal. The purpose of the research idea statement is for the interview panel to understand the research you are interested in and the appropriateness of the EdD for your professional development.

You will need to identify the intended research area/issue/topic. Provide contextual information on the rationale for choosing this topic and the intended contribution of the research outcomes to the profession. This should include background reading on the topic area, including relevant policy and theoretical frameworks drawn from academic literature with which you are familiar. This can be researched via internet resources such as google scholar.

The research idea should set out some general research aims, what you want to focus on, who you would anticipate collecting research data from, and what type of information/data would you be interested in collecting. Ethical and operational challenges to carrying the research can also be high lighted.

Guidance on writing the Personal Statement

The Personal Statement should be approximately 800 words. Your statement should focus on your career to date and the contribution that studying for a Professional Doctorate in Education will provide an opportunity to support an aspect of your professional practice, thereby contributing to your professional development and future career. You can highlight the professional and academic skills you have acquired and the motivations for the research idea.

References and Qualifications Check

As a procedure to fight against false documents and qualifications, you are requested to authorise the EdD programme team to contact relevant parties to check and validate the authenticity of the submitted qualifications and references.

- * The admission requirements of English proficiency we set for the MSc programmes delivered at HKUSPACE align to this:
