ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

Objective

This programme is UNIQUE in terms of its scope of diversity and its specialist focus. It is multidisciplinary with specialism in Business Forensics and Governance & Crisis

Management. Upon completion of 2 core and Any four elective modules, students will be awarded with Postgraduate Diploma in Enterprise Risk Management.



Articulation to MSc Risk Management

Graduates who have completed the pre-requisite modules, would be exempted 120 credits and only need to study 'Research Methods'

and also submit a 12,000- word dissertation to attain the award of MSc Risk Management* offered by Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU).

- [^] Pre-requisite modules: Business and Professional Ethics, Enterprise Risk Management Framework, Corporate Governance, Financial and Business Risk Management and Business Interruption Crisis Management.
- * This is an exempted course under the Non-local Higher and Professional Education (Regulation) Ordinance. It is a matter of discretion for individual employers to recognize any qualification to which this course may lead.

PROGRAMME DELIVERY

Each academic year is divided into trimesters (February, June and October). This provides benefits of maximum flexibility for students to enroll in different points in time and plan their pace of studies. All students are required to complete the whole programme in a maximum period of three years.

All classes will be held in weekday evenings or weekends in the HKU SPACE learning centres.

This programme is recognised by the Institute of Paralegals in the United Kingdom. The Institute is a UK professional body for paralegals which sets national competency standards for paralegals and others non-lawyers working in the law. It is also Europe's leading paralegal professional body (see http://www.InstituteofParalegals.org).

Programme Structure

On completing six modules, which consist of two core modules and any four elective modules, students will be awarded with a Postgraduate Diploma. The programme consists of 11 modules, duration of each module ranges from 33 to 36 contact hours. The Postgraduate Diploma programme is entitled to CEF reimbursement.

Assessment

Students will be assessed on the basis of their performances in examinations and continuous assessments that make up a total of 100%. Students are required to pass both the continuous assessment and the final examination in order to obtain an overall pass for a module.

Award

The award of Postgraduate Diploma in Enterprise Risk Management will be conferred upon successful completion of all the SIX modules with a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 1.0.

APPLICATION

- Applicants are required to submit the application form with supporting documents at HKU SPACE Enrolment Centres in person or via online.
- Please present the academic documents and HKID (both original and copies for verification) for the application process.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants shall:

- a) hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline awarded by a recognized institution; and
- b) provide evidence of English proficiency (if the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English) such as:
 - i) an overall band of 6.0 with no subtests lower than 5.5 in the IELTS; or
 - ii) a score of 550 in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 in the computer-based TOEFL, or a score of 80 in the internet-based TOEFL; or
 - iii) HKALE Use of English at Grade E; or
 - iv) HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 3; or
 - v) other equivalent qualifications.

Applicants with other qualifications will be considered on individual merit.
